4 MEMORANDUM REPORTS

4.1 2025/26 SEALED ROAD RESURFACING PROGRAMME

2.05 The purpose of this report was to provide the 2025/26 Sealed Road Resurfacing Programme to the Roading Sub-Committee.

Council adopted the 2025/35 Long Term Plan with budget for road resurfacing for the current 2025/26 financial year. In doing so, Council approved a \$2.67 million investment in Sealed Road Resurfacing.

Joshua Rendell presented this report. Council was currently out for tender with this contract.

Questions were asked about the timing of road works and working around other work such as forestry harvesting.

It was noted that the roads chosen for re-sealing were not "drawn out of a hat", but there was a formula followed that considered the age of the seal and the need to maintain and water proof the road

Further discussion took place on unsealed roads and other matters.
